In continuing our pledge to plant 15,000 trees each year through #PAL Plant A Legacy Project, we are requesting each one of you to plant at least three trees **by March 21st**.

The requirements for the tree plantation are as follows:

Step 1- Plant three tree saplings in the earth anywhere in the world (not a potted plant).

Step 2- Take a picture of the person who planted the tree holding a placard which says #PAL-PLANT A LEGACY.

Step 3- Upload all the three photographs in the <u>link</u> and mention the location they are planted in.

Step 4- Make sure someone cares for the plant that has been planted.
