

STUDENT SAFETY AND WELL-BEING

Dear Parents,

In line with our commitment to safeguarding, we emphasize that every child has the right to grow and learn in a safe, secure, and respectful environment where they feel protected and cared for.

Parents are requested to support the school in inculcating safe behaviour, discipline, and respect for others among children. Kindly ensure that students bring only the prescribed books and materials to school and avoid carrying any items that may cause harm or distraction. Regular checking of school bags, reinforcing safety practices at home, and promptly informing the school about any health or safety concerns will greatly contribute to maintaining a secure and nurturing learning environment.

As students' progress to higher classes, they are expected to exhibit increased responsibility, maturity, and self-discipline. Parents are encouraged to guide their children in making informed and responsible choices, maintaining appropriate conduct, and always adhering to school rules. Students must strictly refrain from bringing prohibited items such as vapes, cigarettes, alcohol, or any harmful substances. Parents should continue to monitor their child's belongings, foster accountability, and collaborate with the school in addressing any behavioural or safety concerns, thereby supporting the overall development of responsible and aware individuals.

Items Not Permitted to Be Brought to School (All Grades) :

- **Sharp objects** (knives, blades, pointed items)
Alternative: Only child-safe, school-approved stationery as per class requirements
- **Metal spoons and forks**
Alternative: Use **wooden spoons and forks** that are safe and lightweight
- **Metal scissors or any scissors not approved by the school**
Alternative: **Child-safe scissors (rounded edge and plastic)** only when instructed
- **Toys that may cause injury or distraction**

Students are strictly prohibited from bringing valuable items such as jewellery or large amounts of cash, as well as vapes, cigarettes, alcohol, any harmful substances, and fireworks, matches, lighters, or other inflammable materials.

Parent Responsibilities & Support:

- Conduct routine school bag checks at home.
- Ensure children carry only required materials to school.
- Reinforce safety rules and discipline expectations.
- Educate children about the dangers of prohibited items.
- Maintain open communication with children regarding school behaviour.
- Promptly inform the school about any health, emotional, or safety concerns.
- Support and cooperate with the school in maintaining a safe and respectful environment.

School Responsibilities & Support:

- Reinforce safety rules and discipline expectations.
- Conduct regular bag checks in school to ensure compliance with safety guidelines.
- Implement and regularly review safety policies and procedures.
- Provide a safe, secure, and inclusive learning environment.
- Conduct awareness programmes and guidance sessions on safety, behaviour, and well-being.
- Offer counselling and support services for students when required.
- Maintain effective communication with parents regarding student welfare and concerns.
- Take appropriate and timely action to address any safety or disciplinary issues.

The safety and well-being of our students remain our highest priority. Together let's make the school and home a positive and safe learning environment for our children.
