NEW ELECTIVE - COMMERCIAL ART (GRADES 11 & 12)

Dear Parents,

We are pleased to inform you that based on the responses from the survey conducted, **Applied Art – Commercial Art (Code No. 052)** will be offered as an elective **sixth subject** for students in **Grades 11 and 12**.

One of the significant advantages of opting for an additional elective subject is that, as per CBSE regulations, if a student takes six subjects and is unable to pass in any one of the first five subjects, the marks obtained in the sixth subject may be considered in its place, provided the student continues to satisfy the CBSE Scheme of Studies. This means that after the replacement, either **English or Hindi** must remain among the five main subjects.

To facilitate this opportunity **Applied Art – Commercial Art (Code No. 052) will be incorporated into the school timetable from September 2026 onwards**.

We encourage parents and students to explore this option, which not only nurtures creativity and artistic expression but also provides an additional academic advantage.
