Act Responsible, Think Sustainable

A Reggio-Inspired Exhibition put up by our students from Grades 1 and 2, is an artistic creation and expression of our student's exploration and engagement with the sustainable developmental goals, which will make all of us pause, ponder and reflect on our lives.

The Reggio Emilia inspired approach to early childhood education focuses on celebrating the hundred languages of students to make student thinking visible. The hundred languages of students refer to the many forms of expression students use to interact with their world. The focus is on the students thought process and not on the product. The role of the teacher is only as a facilitator who observes, probes students' thinking with provocations, listens to their questions and their stories, finds what interests them and then provides them with a range of natural materials and opportunities to explore these interests further. With remote learning, the teacher and the parent have together facilitated this enquiry, the outcome of which you will see in the virtual exhibition.
