PROJECT EMPATHY

Dear Parents,

Empathy Week is a global schools programme, which is celebrated all over the world to enable students discover and build empathy.

As part of the problem-based learning approach at GLS, students learnt about the SD Goal #14 Life below water and SD Goal # 15 Life on land, among other SDGs. They were concerned and intrigued by the fact that plastic is harming the animals on both land and water. Our students empathized with the animals and campaigned for reducing the use of single use plastic bags and promote the use of cloth bags instead. In line with the recent UAE ban on the use of single use plastic bags a student-led campaign is being launched as part of the Empathy Month projects from 21st February to 18th March 2022.

Our students will be participating in several empathy projects during this month.

Building empathy through films

All students from Kindergarten to grade 6 will watch five inspirational short films telling the stories of amazing and unique individuals followed by group discussions helping to foster a deeper understanding of empathy and its applications in the real world.

Circle time – Empathy time

Students in Kindergarten will explore the different forms of empathy through puppets.

Reggio inspired Exhibition

Inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach the students from Kindergarten to Grade 2 will present their explorations and understanding of empathy through a Reggio Exhibition in the second week of March.

Empathy towards nature –Designing of cloth bags

This activity is in line with banning the single use plastic bags and moving to cloth bags. We would provide the cloth bags and our students will be designing their own bags with their creative minds, using only reused materials keeping zero waste at the heart of this project.

We encourage every parent to buy the bag designed by his or her own child for a nominal amount of AED 5 and use the bag for their weekly shopping.

Please find a few exemplars of the cloth bags, which our students will be designing using reused materials.
