SHARE A BOOK! STRENGTHEN YOUR LIBRARY!

Dear Parent,

The Right to Read is an initiative by the GEMS Legacy School to enable each child to develop their reading skills. Right to Read is an opportunity for our students to learn about different perspectives and understand why people do what they do.

Under the umbrella of 'Right to Read' and following the school's culture of sustainable practices, students are encouraged to share a book with the school library that allows not only them but also their peers access to the book once they are done reading. This initiative hopes to celebrate the joy of reading by giving every child a new, used, or borrowed book and thus creating a learning exchange.

The Process:

1. Bring a book(s) that you have already finished reading to the school library.
2. The book(s) must be unused or in considerably good condition.
3. Register the book(s) with the school librarian.
4. Encourage a peer to check out the book from the library and read it.
5. Once they have finished reading the book, share your thoughts and reflections about the book with each other.
6. The books will be placed in a special section of the libraries on both campuses and made available to all students on a rotational basis.
