Grades 2 & 3

Apple I Pad- 7th generation or above. Screen size 9.7 inch (Minimum) Android Tablets -Android version 12 or later (Higher versions recommended). Screen size 8.5 Inch (Minimum) (We highly recommend I Pad's for Grade 2 and 3 students as a durable device)

Grades 4 & above

Windows Laptop's Minimum Requirements: -Windows 10/11 Operating System/Intel Core-i5 Processor/8 GB RAM/256GB HDD Office 365/ with Licensed Antivirus. (We prefer thin Laptops for Students from Grades 4 and above)

Apple MacBook -MacOS Version 11(Big Sur) or Later

(We recommend Windows Laptops or Apple MacBooks for students of Grades 4 and above)
