## How You Can Help:

We encourage you to actively participate in the E-Waste Collection Campaign by:

• **Contributing E-Waste:** Search your homes for old and unused electronic devices as listed below. These items, if not disposed of correctly, can harm the environment. Your contribution can make a significant difference.

• **Encouraging Your Child:** Teach your child about the importance of responsible e-waste disposal and support them in their efforts to collect e-waste from your home and the neighborhood.

• **Promoting Environmental Awareness:** Take this opportunity to discuss with your child the broader environmental issues related to e-waste, such as recycling, resource conservation, and the impact on our planet.

## **Certification:**

- 1. Each school will receive an official certificate stating the amount of e-waste collected, issued by our esteemed green recycling partner.
- 2. The names of the top three contributing students will be submitted at the end of the collection period.

## What Can be contributed as E-Waste are as below:

- Large household appliances.
- Small household appliances.
- Smartphones, smartwatches, chargers, earphones, accessories.
- Laptops, chargers, printers, monitors, tablets, Gaming devices, keyboard.
- Consumer electronics, such as smartphones, televisions and computers.
- Light fixtures.
- Electrical Toys.
- Electric Tools.
- Medical devices.
- Monitoring instruments, Health devices, thermostats, and weight scales.
- Automatic dispensers, such as vending machines.
- Anything with a battery, wire or plug etc.

Please pack the items securely and label them mentioning the following details:

- Name of the Student
- Grade
- Section

Please note that in line with the school's health and safety policy within the school, we request you to drop off the e-waste at school if the collection is more than what the children can carry on their own. Smaller bags of e-waste can be brought onto the buses by the children. Please ensure that the e-waste you contribute is in proper condition and does not pose any safety hazards. Be responsible and take care while handling electronic items.
